We would like to inform you that the Solicitation of Membership for the Aircraft Noise Advisory Committee was posted in the [Federal Register](#) this morning. As stated in the Federal Register Notice:

"The Committee shall comprise at least nine members, with at least one representative from each of the following stakeholder groups: engine manufacturers, air carriers, airport owners or operators, aircraft manufacturers, advanced air mobility manufacturers or operators, institutions of higher education, and representatives of airport-adjacent communities from geographically diverse regions. Members will serve for 2-year terms but may be reappointed. DOT is interested in ensuring membership is balanced fairly in terms of the points of view represented and the functions to be performed by the advisory committee."
